

Nominate A Young Person

Membership in clubs and teams, along with academic and athletic achievements, is fine, but the most important criteria are how one lives his/her faith.

There is no nomination form. We ask that you prepare a nomination essay (no more than 200 words) about the individual and include a photo of the young person (school photo will suffice).
